2 **Electric Service Quality and Reliability Standards – Deadlines**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the dates by which the Public Service Commission is
4 required to determine whether certain electric companies have met certain
5 service quality and reliability standards under certain circumstances; altering
6 the date by which certain electric companies are required to submit to the
7 Commission a certain annual performance report; and generally relating to
8 electric service quality and reliability standards.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (f) (1) On or before [July] **SEPTEMBER** 1, 2013, and [July] **SEPTEMBER**

3 (g) (1) On or before [February] **APRIL** 1 of each year, each electric
4 company shall submit to the Commission an annual performance report that
5 summarizes the actual electric service reliability results for the preceding year.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 2012.
