## Employees' Pension System – Somerset County Economic Development Commission – Eligible Governmental Unit

4 FOR the purpose of adding the Somerset County Economic Development Commission 5 as an eligible governmental unit in the Employees' Pension System; providing 6 that certain individuals are not subject to the reformed contributory pension 7 benefit in the Employees' Pension System; providing that certain individuals are subject to the alternate contributory pension benefit in the Employees' 8 9 Pension System in the same manner as certain other individuals; providing that certain individuals may become subject to the reformed contributory pension 10 11 benefit in the same manner that an individual who was a member of the Employees' Pension System on a certain date and remains a member on a 12 certain date may be subject to the reformed contributory benefit; providing 13 14 certain employees of the Somerset County Economic Development Commission a certain amount of additional service credit in the Employees' Pension System; 15 prohibiting certain employees of the Somerset County Economic Development 16 Commission from receiving a certain amount of additional service credit in the 17 18 Employees' Pension System; and generally relating to employees of the 19 Somerset County Economic Development Commission participating in the 20 Employees' Pension System.
