- 2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ON-FARM HOME PROCESSING LICENSE" MEANS A 3 LICENSE ISSUED TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO OWNS A FARM TO PROCESS FOOD IN A 4 HOME OR DOMESTIC KITCHEN LOCATED ON THE INDIVIDUAL'S FARM.
- 5 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE THE 6 HOLDER OF AN ON-FARM HOME PROCESSING LICENSE MAY DERIVE FROM FOOD 7 PROCESSED UNDER THE LICENSE.
