## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **On-Farm Home Processing License – Revenue Limit – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Department of Health from limiting the  
4 amount of revenue the holder of an on-farm home processing license may derive from  
5 food processed under the license; and generally relating to on-farm home processing  
6 licenses.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 Article – Health – General  
9 Section 21–301(a) and (i)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2023 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)

12 BY adding to

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Health – General**

20 21–301.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

22 (i) “License” means a license issued by the Department under this subtitle to  
23 operate a food establishment.

2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ON-FARM HOME PROCESSING LICENSE" MEANS A  
3 LICENSE ISSUED TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO OWNS A FARM TO PROCESS FOOD IN A  
4 HOME OR DOMESTIC KITCHEN LOCATED ON THE INDIVIDUAL'S FARM.

5 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE THE  
6 HOLDER OF AN ON-FARM HOME PROCESSING LICENSE MAY DERIVE FROM FOOD  
7 PROCESSED UNDER THE LICENSE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October 1, 2025,  
9 the Maryland Department of Health shall update COMAR 10.15.04.15 to repeal the  
10 \$40,000 limit on sales of food processed under an on-farm home processing license.

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
12 1, 2025.
