- 1 (c) [One year] **TWO YEARS** before the expiration of the term of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall file with the Commission a notice of intent to reapply for the license under this subtitle.
- 4 (d) Within 1 year of the end of the initial 15-year license term, a video lottery 5 operation licensee may reapply for a license that has a license term of 10 years and a license 6 fee to be established by statute.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2017.
