CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sunday Permit – Hours of Sale**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a holder of a certain alcoholic beverages license in
4 Frederick County who has been granted a Sunday opening permit to sell certain
5 alcoholic beverages for ~~off-premises~~ on-premises consumption at a certain event that
6 the Frederick County Board of License Commissioners has approved; providing that
7 the Board set the hours for the event; making this Act an emergency measure; and
8 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick County.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
7 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

9 11–511.

10 (a) This section applies only in Frederick County.

11 (b) This section does not apply to holders of Class E licenses.

12 (c) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, the privilege
13 conferred by every class of “on–sale” license may be exercised during the hours from 6 a.m.
14 to 2 a.m. daily, except Sundays.

15 (2) On Sundays the hours are:

16 (i) On–sale [–]:

17 **1. FROM 11 a.m. to 2 a.m.; OR**

18 **2. FOR A SPECIFIC EVENT THAT THE BOARD OF**
19 **LICENSE COMMISSIONERS HAS APPROVED, THE HOURS FOR THE EVENT THAT ARE**
20 **SET BY THE BOARD; and**

21 (ii) Off–sale – 1 p.m. to 2 a.m.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
23 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
24 been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to
25 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
26 enacted.
