- 5 (1) to the State Law Library, 25 cloth–bound copies of each new Maryland 6 Manual;
- 7 (2) to each member of the General Assembly, 2 cloth–bound copies and 8 other copies of each new Maryland Manual;
- 9 (3) to each public or private educational institution in the State, 1 copy of 10 each new Maryland Manual; and
- 11 (4) to the Legislative Library, 50 cloth–bound copies of each new Maryland 12 Manual.
- 13 (b) If a former member of the General Assembly asks the State Archivist for a 14 copy of the Maryland Manual, the State Archivist shall provide, without charge, a copy of 15 the current Maryland Manual.
- 16 (c) The State Archivist and the Secretary of State may distribute other copies of the Maryland Manual as they consider necessary or desirable.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2017.
