A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Unemployment Insurance Benefits – Disqualification**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that an individual who is otherwise eligible to receive
4 unemployment insurance benefits is disqualified from receiving benefits if the
5 Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation finds that the individual's
6 unemployment resulted from being discharged because the individual was no
7 longer legally able to work in the United States.

8 BY adding to

9 Article – Labor and Employment
10 Section 8–1010
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Labor and Employment**

16 **8–1010.**

17 **AN INDIVIDUAL WHO OTHERWISE IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE BENEFITS IS**
18 **DISQUALIFIED FROM RECEIVING BENEFITS IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT THE**
19 **INDIVIDUAL'S UNEMPLOYMENT RESULTED FROM BEING DISCHARGED BECAUSE**
20 **THE INDIVIDUAL WAS NO LONGER LEGALLY ABLE TO WORK IN THE UNITED**
21 **STATES.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2011.
