1 AN ACT concerning

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### Alcoholic Beverages - Farm Brewery Manufacturer's License

FOR the purpose of creating a Class 8 farm brewery manufacturer's license; specifying a certain annual fee for the license; authorizing a licensee to sell and deliver beer manufactured in a facility on the licensed farm or in another facility to certain persons; requiring that the beer be manufactured in a certain manner; requiring that a farm brewery be located only at the place stated on the license; providing that a licensee may exercise the privileges of the license, notwithstanding local law; specifying the privileges that may be exercised by a licensee, including providing samples of beer, selling certain foods, storing beer, brewing beer, bottling beer, or contracting for a certain number of barrels of beer each calendar year; specifying the times during which a licensee may exercise the privileges of the license; specifying the days of operation for a

licensee; prohibiting a licensee from selling or allowing to be consumed at a 1 2 certain location certain alcoholic beverages other than the beer produced by the 3 licensee under this Act; specifying that certain provisions of law apply to a 4 licensee; authorizing a licensee to sponsor a certain multibrewery activity at the 5 licensed farm under certain conditions; specifying the privileges that a licensee may exercise at a multibrewery activity and the times that the activity may be 6 7 held; authorizing the Office of the Comptroller to issue a special brewery promotional event permit to a licensee under certain conditions; specifying the 8 9 privileges that may be exercised by the licensee at the special brewery promotional event; requiring that the beer at the special brewery promotional 10 event be sold by the glass and for consumption on the premises only; and 11 12 generally relating to Class 8 farm brewery licenses.

EVENT OR OTHER ORGANIZED ACTIVITY AT THE LICENSED FARM.

- 1 (8) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS 2 PARAGRAPH, A CLASS 8 FARM BREWERY LICENSE ALLOWS THE LICENSEE TO 3 OPERATE 7 DAYS A WEEK.
- (II) IN GARRETT COUNTY, A LICENSEE MAY OPEN ON SUNDAYS <u>DURING THE HOURS ALLOWED UNDER § 11–512(C)(3) OF THIS</u>

  ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE ACTIVITIES LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION ONLY IN AN ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE THE VOTERS, IN A REFERENDUM AUTHORIZED BY LAW, HAVE APPROVED SUNDAY SALES AT A FARM.

- 15 (10) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION LIMITS THE APPLICATION OF 16 RELEVANT PROVISIONS OF TITLE 21 OF THE HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE, AND 17 REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THAT TITLE, TO A LICENSEE.
- 18 **(B)** THE PLACE LISTED ON THE CLASS 8 FARM BREWERY LICENSE 19 SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH § 9–103 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- 25 (2) Brew, Bottle, or contract for not more than 15,000 BARRELS OF BEER EACH CALENDAR YEAR;
- 27 (3) CONTRACT WITH THE HOLDER OF A CLASS 5 BREWERY
  28 LICENSE OR A CLASS 2 RECTIFYING LICENSE TO BREW AND BOTTLE BEER FROM
  29 INGREDIENTS PRODUCED ON THE LICENSED FARM;
- 30 (4) IMPORT, EXPORT, AND TRANSPORT ITS BEER IN ACCORDANCE 31 WITH THIS SECTION; AND
- 32 (5) STORE BEER AT A WAREHOUSE FOR WHICH THE LICENSEE 33 HAS BEEN ISSUED AN INDIVIDUAL STORAGE PERMIT, FOR SALE AND DELIVERY 34 TO A WHOLESALER LICENSED IN THE STATE OR A PERSON OUTSIDE OF THE

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- STATE AUTHORIZED TO ACQUIRE THE BEER, OR SHIPMENT BACK TO THE 1 2 LICENSED FARM, IF: 3 **(I)** THE LICENSEE DOES NOT SERVE OR SELL BEER AT THE 4 **WAREHOUSE; AND** 5 THE COMPTROLLER HAS FULL ACCESS AT ALL TIMES (II)6 TO THE WAREHOUSE TO ENFORCE THIS ARTICLE. 7 (D) **(1)** A LICENSEE MAY SPONSOR A MULTIBREWERY ACTIVITY AT 8 THE LICENSED FARM THAT: 9 **(I)** INCLUDES THE PRODUCTS OF OTHER MARYLAND 10 **BREWERIES; AND** (II) PROVIDES FOR THE SALE OF BEER BY THE GLASS FOR 11 12 CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ONLY. 13 IN A SEGREGATED AREA APPROVED BY THE COMPTROLLER 14 ON THE LICENSED FARM, A LICENSEE MAY STORE THE PRODUCTS OF OTHER MARYLAND BREWERIES FOR THE MULTIBREWERY ACTIVITY. 15 16 THE MULTIBREWERY ACTIVITY: **(3)** 17 (I)MAY BE HELD FROM 10 A.M. TO 10 P.M. EACH DAY; AND MAY NOT EXCEED 3 CONSECUTIVE DAYS. 18 (II)THE OFFICE OF THE COMPTROLLER MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL 19 **(1)** 20 BREWERY PROMOTIONAL EVENT PERMIT TO A LICENSEE. 21**(2)** AT LEAST 15 DAYS BEFORE HOLDING A PLANNED 22PROMOTIONAL EVENT, THE LICENSEE SHALL OBTAIN A PERMIT FROM THE COMPTROLLER BY FILING A NOTICE OF THE PROMOTIONAL EVENT ON THE 23 FORM THAT THE COMPTROLLER PROVIDES. 24 25 **(3)** THE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO CONDUCT AT 26THE LICENSED FARM A PROMOTIONAL EVENT AT WHICH THE LICENSEE MAY: 27 **(I)** PROVIDE SAMPLES OF NOT MORE THAN 6 FLUID
