1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Evaluation of Teachers and Principals – Implementation**
3 **Timeline**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to determine the
5 implementation timeline for the evaluation of teachers and principals in certain
6 schools in the State, notwithstanding certain provisions of law; making this Act
7 an emergency measure; and generally relating to the implementation timeline
8 for the evaluation of teachers and principals.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 **6–202.1.**

18 **(A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, AND SUBJECT**
19 **TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE**
20 **THE IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE FOR THE EVALUATION OF TEACHERS AND**
21 **PRINCIPALS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE STATE.**

22 **(B) THE IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE DETERMINED UNDER**
23 **SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT IMPLEMENT AN EVALUATION**
24 **SYSTEM BEFORE JUNE 30, 2015.**

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
2 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
3 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
4 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
5 the date it is enacted.
