19	(a) There is an Education Trust Fund which is a special, nonlapsing fund that is
20	not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
21 22	(b) (1) There shall be credited to the Education Trust Fund all proceeds allocated to the Fund under $\S~9-1A-27$ of this subtitle.

Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be invested and reinvested

- 1 (c) Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be used to:
- 2 (1) provide funding for public elementary and secondary education,
- 3 through continuation of the funding and formulas established under the programs
- 4 commonly known as the Bridge to Excellence in Public Schools Act, first enacted by Chapter
- 5 288 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002, including the funding for regional
- 6 differences in the cost of education under § 5–202(f) of the Education Article;
- 7 (2) provide funds to construct public school buildings and provide public
- 8 school capital improvements in accordance with §§ 5–301 through 5–303 of the Education
