3 4	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 16	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024:
17 18 19 20	(a) On or after October 1, 2026, the Department of Commerce shall conduct a study to determine the perceivable impact of out—of—state dealers of motor homes or recreational trailers displaying or exhibiting at vehicle shows in the State at the Maryland RV Show at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium.
21 22 23	(b) On or before December 1, 2026, the Department of Commerce shall report the findings of the study conducted under subsection (a) of this section, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

October 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 8 months and, at the end of May 31, 2027, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall

be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
