## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Class C–3 Club License**

3 FOR the purpose of removing the requirement in Harford County for a country club to  
4 maintain a certain number of tennis courts to be eligible for a Class C–3 club  
5 alcoholic beverages license; and generally relating to eligibility for a Class C–3  
6 club alcoholic beverages license in Harford County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
9 Section 6–301(n)(6)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2011 Replacement Volume)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

15 6–301.

16 (n) (6) (i) In this paragraph the following words have the meanings  
17 indicated.

18 1. “Miscellaneous organization or club” means a country  
19 club, a yacht or boat club, or topiary garden.
