Consumer Protection – Scanning or Swiping Identification Cards and Driver's
Licenses – Prohibition

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using a scanning device to scan or swipe an 5 identification card or a driver's license of an individual to obtain the personal 6 information of the individual; prohibiting a person from retaining, selling, or 7 transferring to another person any information collected from scanning or swiping 8 an individual's identification card or driver's license under certain circumstances; 9 making a violation of this Act an unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practice under the Maryland Consumer Protection Act and subject to certain enforcement and 10 11 penalty provisions; and generally relating to scanning or swiping identification cards 12 and driver's licenses.
