## 1 AN ACT concerning

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### State Board of Education - Membership - Teachers and Parent

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the State Board of Education to add a 4 certain number of members who are certified teachers and a parent of a certain 5 student; authorizing the teacher members to be appointed to the State Board 6 although the individuals are subject to the authority of the State Board; requiring 7 the Governor to appoint certain teacher members with the advice and consent of the Senate from a certain list certain lists submitted to the Governor by the State 8 9 Department of Education after an election by teachers in the State by certain 10 organizations; requiring the Department to provide notice of a certain vacancy to 11 certain individuals and organizations; requiring a certain election to be conducted 12 under regulations that the Department adopts: requiring the Governor to appoint a 13 certain parent member with the advice and consent of the Senate from a certain list 14 submitted to the Governor by the Maryland PTA; requiring the Department to 15 provide notice of a certain vacancy to the Maryland PTA; providing for the 16 appointment and terms of certain initial teacher members and the initial parent 17 member of the State Board; and generally relating to teacher and parent members 18 of the State Board of Education.

14 15 16	(ii) one teacher member shall serve for a term of 2 years and 6 months beginning January 1, 2019, and terminating at the end of June 30, 2021, or until a successor is appointed and qualifies; and
