- or a wholesaler's license to sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to a holder of a retail alcoholic beverages license on Sunday; authorizing holders of certain classes of retail
- 6 alcoholic beverages licenses to sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday during the same
- hours as on the other days of the week; making certain conforming changes; and
- 8 generally relating to the sales of alcoholic beverages on Sunday in Baltimore County.
