A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Employees – Job Titles, Position Descriptions, and Compensation Levels

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Director of the Behavioral Health Administration to $\mathbf{5}$ compensate certain employees of the Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center who are 6 required to attend a certain correctional training school at a certain pay rate; 7 requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to review certain positions 8 filled by certain State employees who are required to work with certain individuals; 9 specifying the content of a certain review; requiring the Secretary to report certain findings to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating 10 11 to the compensation of employees of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (a) The head of the Administration is the Director and shall be appointed by the 2 Secretary.

3 (b) The Director serves at the pleasure of the Secretary.

4 (c) The Director is entitled to the salary provided in the State budget.

6 (a) The Director is responsible for carrying out the powers, duties, and 7 responsibilities of the Administration.

8 (E) THE DIRECTOR SHALL COMPENSATE EMPLOYEES AT THE CLIFTON T. 9 PERKINS HOSPITAL CENTER WHO ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND A CORRECTIONAL 10 TRAINING SCHOOL APPROVED BY THE CORRECTIONAL TRAINING COMMISSION AT 11 A PAY RATE EQUIVALENT TO SIMILAR EMPLOYEES IN THE DIVISION OF 12 CORRECTION.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene conduct a review of all positions
filled by State employees, including employees at the Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center,
who are required to work with individuals ordered by the court to receive treatment
services from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

18 (b) The review required under subsection (a) of this section shall include a 19 determination of an employee's:

- 20 (1) job title;
- 21 (2) position description; and
- 22 (3) level of compensation.

(c) On or before December 1, 2017, the Secretary shall report to the General
Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the findings of
the review required under subsection (a) of this section.

26 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 27 1, 2017.

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
