## 1 **(F)** THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$900. 2 32 - 1601.3 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Board may not 4 issue a license for an establishment that is within 500 feet of a place of worship or a public 5 or private elementary or secondary school. 6 (2)The distance from the establishment to the place of worship or the 7 public or private elementary or secondary school is to be the distance that an individual 8 could walk directly from the main entrance of the establishment to the main entrance of 9 the place of worship or school. 10 (b) A person may apply for a license within 6 months following the termination of a license at an existing location that falls within the restriction imposed by 11 12 subsection (a) of this section. 13 (2)The prohibition against issuing a license in subsection (a) of this section 14 does not apply to: 15 (i) a temporary license; [or] 16 the Downtown Plaza of Salisbury that: (ii) 17 is within the area starting from the intersection of 1.
