13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

16 **10–207.**

17 **ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH CORPORATION THAT**
18 **HAS BEEN AWARDED A CONTRACT BY THE STATE FOR OVER \$250,000 DURING**
19 **THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE BOARD ON THE**
