~~[(e)] (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, [a spouse or financially dependent child of an active duty member] AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION who enrolls as an entering student in a public institution of higher education [and] IN THE STATE is exempt from paying nonresident tuition [under subsection (b) of this section shall continue to be exempt from paying nonresident tuition] AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE if:~~

~~[(1)] (I) The active duty [member no longer meets the requirements of subsection (b)(1) of this section] OR RETIRED MEMBER WAS STATIONED IN THE STATE AT ANY TIME; and~~

8 (3) **“ELIGIBLE STUDENT” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:**

9 (i) **IS A FINANCIALLY DEPENDENT CHILD OF AN ACTIVE DUTY**
10 **MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES OR AN HONORABLY DISCHARGED**
11 **VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES;**

12 (ii) **WAS ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC OR NONPUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL**
13 **IN THE STATE FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR DURING THE 3 YEARS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE**
14 **SEEKING ENROLLMENT IN A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY**
15 **SYSTEM OF MARYLAND; AND**

16 (iii) **WAS A RESIDENT OF OR DOMICILED IN THE STATE WHILE**

20 (C) **THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO ENCOURAGE AND ASSIST**
21 **ELIGIBLE STUDENTS WHO ONCE LIVED IN MARYLAND TO RETURN TO THE STATE**
22 **AND ATTEND A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF**
23 **MARYLAND.**

24 (D) **AN ELIGIBLE STUDENT IS EXEMPT FROM PAYING THE NONRESIDENT**
25 **TUITION RATE AT A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF**

27 (E) **THE PROGRAM SHALL BE LIMITED TO 100 ELIGIBLE STUDENTS.**

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before June 30, 2017,
2 and June 30, 2018, the University System of Maryland shall submit a report, in accordance
3 with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly regarding:

4 (1) how many individuals applied to the Return to Maryland Program
5 established in accordance with § 15-106.9 of the Education Article; and

6 (2) how many individuals received awards under the Program.
