## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2012 – Anne Arundel County –**  
3 **Deale Elementary School Technology Enhancement Project**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2012  
5 to authorize a certain grant for the Deale Elementary School Technology  
6 Enhancement Project to include capital equipping; extending the deadline for  
7 the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County to present evidence of a certain  
8 matching fund; and generally relating to amending the Maryland Consolidated  
9 Capital Bond Loan of 2012.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Chapter 444 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2012  
12 Section 1(3) Item ZA02(H)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (H) Deale Elementary School Technology Enhancement Project.  
21 Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$23,000 or (ii) the  
22 amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of  
23 Education of Anne Arundel County for the design,  
24 construction, repair, [and] renovation, AND CAPITAL

1           **EQUIPPING** of the Deale Elementary School Technology  
2           Enhancement Project, located in Deale. **NOTWITHSTANDING**  
3           **SECTION 1(5) OF THIS ACT, THE GRANTEE HAS UNTIL**  
4           **JUNE 1, 2015, TO PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING**  
5           **FUND WILL BE PROVIDED.** (Anne Arundel County) ..... 23,000

6           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7           June 1, 2014.
