## Higher Education – Community Colleges – Workforce Development Sequence Grants and Scholarships

4 FOR the purpose of establishing Workforce Development Sequence grants and scholarships; requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance in the Maryland 5 6 Higher Education Commission to make certain determinations and certain 7 disbursements to certain institutions of higher education under certain 8 circumstances; requiring certain institutions to provide Workforce Development 9 Sequence scholarships to certain students with certain funds; requiring the 10 Commission, in consultation with the Maryland Association of Community Colleges, 11 to develop certain guidelines; requiring certain institutions to consider certain 12 factors in making certain awards; requiring the Governor annually to include a 13 certain appropriation in the State budget for the Workforce Development Sequence 14 grants; authorizing certain students to use certain scholarships for certain purposes; 15 requiring certain institutions to provide the Commission with certain information on 16 or before a certain date each year; requiring the Commission to compile certain 17 information and submit certain information to the Governor and the General 18 Assembly on or before a certain date each year; defining certain terms; and generally 19 relating to Workforce Development Sequence grants and scholarships for community 20 college students.
