1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Physical Education and Athletic Programs for Students with**
3 **Disabilities – Reporting Requirements**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the reporting date for county boards of education to report
5 on certain requirements relating to physical education and athletic programs for
6 students with disabilities; altering the reporting date for the State Department
7 of Education to issue a certain report to the General Assembly; and generally
8 relating to physical education and athletic programs for students with
9 disabilities.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 7-4B-05.

1 (a) On or before [February 1] **MAY 15** of each year, each county board shall
2 submit to the Department a report of the school system's compliance with the
3 provisions of this subtitle.

4 (b) The first annual report completed by a county board in accordance with
5 subsection (a) of this section shall include:

6 (1) The number of students with disabilities that participate in the
7 school system's mainstream physical education or mainstream athletic programs; and

8 (2) A description of plans by the county board to affirmatively engage
9 students with disabilities in mainstream physical education or mainstream athletic
10 programs.

11 (c) Reports submitted by a county board subsequent to the report submitted
12 under subsection (b) of this section shall be consistent with regulations adopted by the
13 State Board.

14 (d) On or before [May] **AUGUST 1** of each year, the Department shall,
15 subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, submit to the General Assembly a
16 report of compliance with the provisions of this subtitle.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 July 1, 2010.
