- 7 (2) INCLUDE INFORMATION ON HOW THE PROJECT WOULD ALIGN 8 WITH OTHER EXISTING BENEFITS PROGRAMS;
- 9 (3) IDENTIFY ELIGIBILITY GROUPS AND ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH 10 ALL FEDERAL DISABILITY AND CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS, INCLUDING EXCEPTIONS AND
- 11 ACCOMMODATIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH PROHIBITIVE HEALTH CONDITIONS;
- 12 (4) IDENTIFY A RANGE OF QUALIFYING WORK AND COMMUNITY 13 ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES TAILORED TO SPECIFIC POPULATIONS;
- 14 **(5) D**ESCRIBE THE SUPPORT SERVICES AVAILABLE TO ASSIST 15 INDIVIDUALS IN MEETING REQUIREMENTS; AND
- 16 **(6) D**ESCRIBE STATE-SPECIFIC EMPLOYMENT BARRIERS AND HOW 17 THE STATE WILL ADDRESS THOSE BARRIERS.
- 18 (C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2018, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT
- 19 TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE
- 20 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE STATUS OF THE DEPARTMENT'S APPLICATION
- 21 UNDER THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
