A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Employees' Retirement and Pension Systems – Employer Contributions –**
3 **Baltimore City Sheriff's Department**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring Baltimore City to pay certain employer contributions,
5 beginning on a certain date, for certain employees of the Baltimore City
6 Sheriff's Department who are members of the Employees' Retirement System or
7 Employees' Pension System; and generally relating to the payment of employer
8 contributions for members of the Employees' Retirement System or the
9 Employees' Pension System.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Article – State Personnel and Pensions
12 Section 21–307(o)
13 Annotated Code of Maryland
14 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

18 21–307.

19 (o) **(1)** For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and each subsequent
20 fiscal year, for a deputy sheriff employed by the Baltimore City Sheriff's Department
21 who is a member of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System, Baltimore City
22 shall pay the employer contributions otherwise required to be made by the State on
23 behalf of the members.

24 **(2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2010, AND EACH**
25 **SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR, FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE BALTIMORE CITY**

1 **SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT**
2 **SYSTEM OR THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM, BALTIMORE CITY SHALL PAY**
3 **THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS OTHERWISE REQUIRED TO BE MADE BY THE**
4 **STATE ON BEHALF OF THE MEMBERS.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 July 1, 2010.
