A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County and Carroll County – Authority to Place Boundary**
3 **Monuments**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing bodies of Baltimore County and Carroll
5 County to provide for the setting of boundary monuments to mark the boundary
6 line between the two counties in a certain manner; and generally relating to the
7 setting of boundary monuments between Baltimore County and Carroll County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Local Government**

17 **9–114.**

18 **THE GOVERNING BODIES OF BALTIMORE COUNTY AND CARROLL COUNTY**
19 **MAY PROVIDE FOR THE SETTING OF BOUNDARY MONUMENTS TO MARK THE**
20 **BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH:**

21 **(1) THE INITIAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION ENACTED BY CHAPTER**
22 **256 OF THE ACTS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1835 AND CONFIRMED BY**
23 **CHAPTER 19 OF THE ACTS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1836; AND**
