5 (A) THERE IS AN URBAN AGRICULTURE WATER AND POWER 6 INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.

7 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO INCREASE THE VIABILITY OF 8 URBAN FARMING AND COMMUNITY GARDENS AND IMPROVE ACCESS TO 9 URBAN–GROWN FOODS.

11 (A) THERE IS AN URBAN AGRICULTURE WATER AND POWER 12 INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT FUND.

13 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO URBAN 14 AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS AND QUALIFIED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE 15 PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF:

16(1) AGRICULTURE EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH WATER SUPPLY17AND IRRIGATION; AND

18 (2) ELECTRIC POWER ACCESS.

19 (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

20 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 21 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

22 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 23 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

- 24 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 25 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;

26 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND UNDER § 13–209 OF THE 27 TAX – PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND

1 (F) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR:

2 (1) PROVIDING UP TO 87.5% OF MATCHING FUNDS TO URBAN 3 AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS AND QUALIFIED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE 4 PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF:

- 5 (I) WATER METERS;
- 6 (II) WATER PIPES;
- 7 (III) IRRIGATION HOSES;
- 8 (IV) ELECTRIC METERS;
- 9 (V) ELECTRICAL LINES; OR

10 (VI) ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH WATER SUPPLY 11 AND IRRIGATION OR ELECTRIC POWER ACCESS THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES IS 12 APPROPRIATE; AND

13(2)ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO ADMINISTER14THE PROGRAM.
