A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010 – Prince George’s County**
3 **– John E. Feggans Center Renovation**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010
5 to allow a certain grantee to include the value of real property in a certain
6 matching requirement; and generally relating to amending the Maryland
7 Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2010.

9 Chapter 483 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2010
10 Section 1(3) Item ZA02(BF) and Item ZA03(BB–1)
