2	Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §402, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:
3 4 5	<u>1-B. Legislative caucus.</u> "Legislative caucus" means 3 or more Legislators of the same political party meeting for the purpose of conducting legislative business on behalf of the Legislature or a legislative committee.
6 7	<b>Sec. 2. 1 MRSA §402, sub-§2, ¶A,</b> as enacted by PL 1975, c. 758, is amended to read:
8 9	A. The Legislature of Maine and its committees and, subcommittees and legislative caucuses;

11 12 13	This bill provides that legislative caucuses are public proceedings under the Freedom of Access Act. The bill defines "legislative caucus" as 3 or more Legislators of the same political party meeting for the purpose of conducting legislative business.
