Sec. 1 Bureau of Unemployment Compensation within the Department of Labor to determine the most cost-effective proposal for establishing a workplace training program. Resolved: That, within existing resources, the Director of the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation within the Department of Labor shall determine the most cost-effective proposal for establishing a voluntary workplace training program. The director shall examine programs in the states of Georgia, New Hampshire and Utah to guide the study; and be it further

Sec. 2 Reporting date established. Resolved: That, no later than December 15, 2011, the Director of the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation within the Department of Labor shall report the results of the study under section 1 along with any recommended legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development. The committee may submit a bill related to the report to the Second Regular Session of the 125th Legislature.
