8 1. Special taste-testing festival license. Malt liquor manufacturers licensed under 9 section 1401 and manufacturers of malt liquor or wine licensed as small breweries or small wineries under section 1355-A may apply jointly for an additional license to 10 participate in a special taste-testing festival under this section. A small brewery or small 11 winery from another state may participate in a special taste-testing festival under this 12 section. The special taste-testing festival license is valid for no more than 3 consecutive 13 days and may be issued once annually. The bureau may issue up to 5 festival licences per 14 15 year; only one of the licenses may be issued to a person that is not a trade association representing breweries or wineries 16

SUMMARY

18 This bill sets the number of special taste-testing festival licenses statewide at 5 per 19 year, and requires 4 of the 5 licenses to be issued to a trade association that represents 20 breweries or wineries. The bill allows small breweries and wineries from other states to 21 participate in special taste-testing festivals. This bill increases the fee for a special taste-22 testing festival license from \$10 to \$50 per day of the festival and clarifies that the event, 23 rather than a participant, is licensed.
