1       **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2               **Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1124** is enacted to read:

3       **§1124. Illegal importation of synthetic hallucinogenic drugs**

4               1. A person is guilty of illegal importation of synthetic hallucinogenic drugs if the  
5 person intentionally or knowingly conveys or causes to be conveyed a synthetic  
6 hallucinogenic drug into the State from another state or country, unless the person is  
7 authorized to import or to possess the synthetic hallucinogenic drug under any law of the  
8 United States, of another state or of a foreign country.

9               2. A violation of this section is a Class D crime.

10   **SUMMARY**

11               This bill prohibits the importation of synthetic hallucinogenic drugs.
