1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1125, sub-§6-F is enacted to read:
3	6-F. Participation in political action committees. A certified candidate may not
4	establish a political action committee with the primary purpose of electing that certified
5	candidate to a position of leadership in the State Senate or House of Representatives for
6	which that certified candidate is a principal officer, fund-raiser or decision maker.

8	This bill prohibits a certified candidate under the Maine Clean Election Act from
9	establishing a political action committee with the primary purpose of electing that
10	candidate to a position of leadership in the State Senate or House of Representatives for
