An Act To Reimburse Philip Wolley for Litigation Expenses Incurred in Connection with His Termination and Reinstatement as a State Employee

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides funds to reimburse Philip Wolley for attorney's fees, expenses and interest based on the rate charged by the Maine Public Employees Retirement System for the reinstatement of past service credits.
