An Act To Limit the Placement of Motor Vehicle Inspection Stickers in Automobiles

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1758, sub-§1,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
- 1. Windshield placement. If a motor vehicle meets the inspection standard, an official inspection sticker must be placed in the lower lefthand corner of the windshield or in the center of the windshield in back of the rearview mirror.
 - **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1766, sub-§7** is enacted to read:
- 7. Size of inspection sticker. An inspection sticker under this section must be at least 3 inches in height and at least 4 inches in width.

SUMMARY

This bill requires that a motor vehicle inspection sticker be placed only in the lower lefthand corner of the vehicle's windshield and that the sticker must be at least 3 inches high and 4 inches wide.
