A bill to amend 1941 PA 207, entitled "Fire prevention code,"

by amending section 7b (MCL 29.7b).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7b. (1) The following items shall must meet the
- 2 appropriate requirements for resistance to fire prescribed in the
- 3 standard methods of fire tests for flame-resistant textiles, films,
- 4 national fire protection association No. 701-1969: fire resistance
- 5 requirements of not less than 1 standard described in subsection
- 6 (3):
- 7 (a) A tent which that may be occupied or furnished for public
- 8 assembly by 50 or more people.
- 9 (b) A tent in which animals are stabled for public exhibition

- 1 or sale.
- 2 (c) A tent located within a building used by the public.
- 3 (d) All tarpaulins and decorative material used in connection
- 4 with any of the above.a tent described in subdivision (a), (b), or
- 5 (c).
- **6** (2) A safety net or tent used for recreational camping is
- 7 exempt from this section.
- 8 (3) After October 1, 1975, all camping tentage of new
- 9 manufacture sold in this state shall comply with the provisions for
- 10 resistance to fire as prescribed in the specification for flame-
- 11 resistant materials used in camping tentage, canvas products
- 12 association international-84, 1974, or another nationally
- 13 recognized standard that is acceptable to the director.
- 14 (3) Only the following standards may be used to meet the fire
- 15 resistance requirements under subsection (1):
- 16 (a) NFPA 701 (2023), "Standard Methods of Fire Tests for Flame
- 17 Propagation of Textiles and Films".
- 18 (b) Another standard that is determined, in rules promulgated
- 19 by the bureau, to be equivalent to the standard described in
- 20 subdivision (a).
- 21 (4) If the standard described in subsection (3)(a) is revised
- 22 after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this
- 23 subsection, the bureau may take notice of the revision and
- 24 determine whether the revision relates to this section. If the
- 25 bureau determines that the revision relates to this section, the
- 26 revision may be incorporated by reference in rules promulgated by
- 27 the bureau.
- 28 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 29 after the date it is enacted into law.
