# FY 2020-21 Supplemental Boilerplate Items

# **GENERAL SECTIONS**

### Sec. 201. State Spending and State Appropriations Paid to Local Units of Government

Estimates total state spending from state sources and payments to be made to local units of government.

#### Sec. 202. Appropriations Subject to Management and Budget Act

Subjects appropriations to the Management and Budget Act, 1984 PA 431.

# Sec. 203. State Administrative Board Transfers

Authorizes the legislature, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, to inter-transfer funds if the State Administrative Board transfers funds.

# MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS

### Sec. 301. Grants for Eligible Soldiers

Requires the department to issue a one-time grant to eligible soldiers who deployed to Washington D.C. in support of the Capitol Response II mission; requires the department to divide the total amount of funding donated, up to \$110,000, by the number of eligible soldiers who deployed.
