FY 2022-23 Supplemental Appropriation Items

1. Panic Alarms (Sec. 97g)

Provides \$6.7 million GF/GP for districts and ISDs to implement at least one panic alarm in each school building. This would provide an estimated \$2,000 per school building. Funding is tie-barred to HB 4241. Note: HB 4242 was drafted before enactment of 2023 PA 103 and will require a conflict substitute. Sec. 97g is used for Cybersecurity Risk Assessments in 2023 PA 103.
