## **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 4279 would amend the Revised School Code to allow an intermediate school district (ISD) to contract with another ISD for the purposes of operating a career and technical education (CTE) program, and to add language specifying that money raised through a CTE millage can be spent on a program that is operated under a contract with another ISD. This would apply to millages authorized after the effective date of the bill.

MCL 380.681 and 380.684

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state or on school districts, ISDs, or public school academies (PSAs).
