House Bill 4449 would create a new act to designate Vaisakhi as a holiday in Michigan. Specifically, the legislature would declare that April 13 and 14 of each year shall be known as "Vaisakhi" or "Baisakhi," a significant holy day for Sikhs and Hindus.
