1.8	(1) data-centered learning opportunities on the dangers of opioid use in middle and high
1.9	schools and communities in Minnesota;
1.10	(2) instruction on prevention strategies, assessing personal risk, and how to recognize
1.11	overdose;
1.12	(3) information on emerging drug trends, including but not limited to fentanyl, xylazine,
1.13	and pressed pills; and
