1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 609.74, is amended to read:
1.6	609.74 PUBLIC NUISANCE.
1.7	(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), whoever by an act or failure to perform a legal
1.8	duty intentionally does any of the following is guilty of maintaining a public nuisance,
1.9	which is a misdemeanor:
1.10	(1) maintains or permits a condition which unreasonably annoys, injures or endangers
1.11	the safety, health, morals, comfort, or repose of any considerable number of members of
1.12	the public; or
1.13	(2) interferes with, obstructs, or renders dangerous for passage, any public highway or
1.14	right-of-way, or waters used by the public; or
1.15	(3) is guilty of any other act or omission declared by law to be a public nuisance and for
1.16	which no sentence is specifically provided.
1.17	(b) It is a gross misdemeanor for a person to violate paragraph (a), clause (2), on a
