1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 169.18, subdivision 10, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 10. **Slow-moving vehicle.** ~~Upon all roadways any~~ (a) A person operating a vehicle
1.8 ~~proceeding~~ at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the
1.9 ~~existing conditions then existing shall be driven~~ must drive in the right-hand lane ~~then~~
1.10 ~~available for traffic~~, or as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway;
1.11 ~~except when.~~ A person who violates this paragraph must pay a fine of not less than \$100.

1.12 (b) Paragraph (a) does not apply if:

1.13 (1) the vehicle is overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction;
