The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Government Operations and Elections Policy

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; requiring exclusive representative for personal care
1.3 attendants to notify members of certain terms; requiring exclusive representative
1.4 to allow personal care attendants to terminate membership with 30-day notice;
1.5 amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 179A.52, by adding subdivisions.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 179A.52, is amended by adding a
1.8 subdivision to read:

1.9 Subd. 11. Notice. Within 15 days of June 30 and December 30 each year, an
1.10 exclusive representative shall notify members in the appropriate unit under subdivision 2
1.11 that they are not required to be members of the exclusive representative or any employee
1.12 organization, and that nonmembers are not required to pay fair-share fees to the exclusive
1.13 representative.

1.14 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 179A.52, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.15 to read:

1.16 Subd. 12. Opt out. An exclusive representative elected under subdivision 5 shall
1.17 not require more than 30 days' notice for a member to cancel membership without penalty.
