1.7	(a) \$200,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$200,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from
1.8	the general fund to the Board of Water and Soil Resources to negotiate draft agreements
1.9	with the United States Army Corps of Engineers and the United States Environmental
1.10	Protection Agency to assume administration of the section 404 permit program of the federal
1.11	Clean Water Act. This is a onetime appropriation.
