1.5	Section 1. MPCA CAPITAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; METROPOLITAN
1.6	COUNTY.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$ is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency as part of the agency's capital
1.9	assistance program for a grant to a metropolitan county, as defined in Minnesota Statutes,
1.10	section 473.121, subdivision 4, to design, construct, and equip an anaerobic digester
1.11	whose feedstock, on an annual basis, consists of at least 25 percent source-separated
1.12	compostable materials, as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 115A.03, subdivision
1.13	32a. This grant is not available until the agency determines that an amount sufficient to
