1.8	Subd. 3a. Temporary hardship. An assistance unit subject to the time limit in
1.9	section 256J.42, subdivision 1, is eligible to receive assistance under a hardship extension
1.10	from July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2012, if the participant who reached the time limit:
1.11	(1) lives in a county with an unemployment rate of five percent or higher;
1.12	(2) does not qualify for another extension under this section; and
1.13	(3) meets the MFIP eligibility criteria in this chapter, except the requirement that the
1.14	participant be in compliance in the 60th month of receiving assistance.
