1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; limiting paid leave for state employees who are
1.3 subjects of investigations; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 43A.05, by
1.4 adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 43A.05, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 8. Leave during investigation. The commissioner must ensure that no state
1.9 employee is placed on paid leave of more than 60 days related to a single workplace
1.10 investigation. After 60 days, the commissioner must ensure that the employee is terminated,
1.11 returns to work, or is placed on unpaid leave.
