The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education finance; making H1N1 flu prevention activities eligible for  
1.3 health and safety revenue; amending Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 123B.56.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 123B.56, is amended to read:

1.6 **123B.56 HEALTH, SAFETY, AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT.**

1.7 "Health, safety, and environmental management" means school district activities  
1.8 necessary for a district's compliance with state law and rules of the Departments of  
1.9 Health, Labor and Industry, Public Safety, and Pollution Control Agency as well as any  
1.10 related federal standards, including federal standards and best practices designed to  
1.11 protect students and school employees from the H1N1 flu. These activities include hazard  
1.12 assessment, required training, record keeping, and program management.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.14 Sec. 2. **H1N1 PREVENTION.**

1.15 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.56 or 123B.57, a school district  
1.16 may transfer any amount of its approved health and safety revenue for health, safety, and  
1.17 environmental management to H1N1 flu prevention activities.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
