1.8	to the commissioner of transportation, for the local road account for routes of regional
1.9	significance in the local road improvement fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 174.52
1.10	subdivision 4. The appropriation is for the reconstruction of Hennepin County Road
1.11	49 in the city of Dayton.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.13	bond proceeds account in the state transportation fund, the commissioner of management
1.14	and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$2,735,000 in the
1.15	manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections
1.16	16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. The
